

2012 AWARD RULES FOR S.A.G., LLC SHOWS

1. Six Ribbons awarded in all classes.
Points: 7, 5, 3, 2, 1, .5
2. Champion & Reserve Ribbons awarded in each DIVISION and will receive additional points:
Champion 10 points, Reserve 6 points. **Divisional Ribbons will be given out in the Show Office.**
3. Double Points will be awarded for designated show (s). Double Points will only apply to class points.
Champion and Reserve points will remain the same.
4. In the event of a tie in a Hunter Performance Division, the entry with the most points over fences will be declared the Champion. A coin toss will determine the Champion in all other divisions.
5. Year End Awards will be offered at the end of the Show Series. Grand High Points will be accumulated for the entire show series. If a winner of a Year End Award is not on the grounds, arrangements must be made to pick up the award. Awards & ribbons will not be mailed.
6. ALL CLASSES MUST HAVE A MINIMUM OF 3 RIDERS FOR POINTS TO ACCUMULATE TOWARD YEAR END AWARDS
7. **Equitation riders** must ride in **3 shows** in the same Division for points to accumulate toward Year End Awards.
Medal riders may show in the Medal Class at all 4 shows, but must ride in the Medal Class in **3 shows** for points to accumulate toward Year End Awards.
Hunters must be shown in **3 shows** in the same Division for the points to accumulate toward Year End Awards

2012 SAG, LLC SHOW RULES

1. **NO DOGS ALLOWED ON SHOW GROUNDS**
2. Management, the Committee and Shadowbrook at Gettysburg, LLC (SAG, LLC) will not be responsible for any accident which may occur to any exhibitor, owner, attendant, animal, spectator, or equipment at the shows.
3. Management reserves the right to cancel/combine any class or change any heights within the Division rules to accommodate the weather conditions or competitors showing.
4. All exhibitors must wear proper attire which includes hard sole shoes or boots and an approved helmet at all times while mounted on the show grounds. **Full chaps and tank tops are not permitted in any class.**
5. The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania requires that all horses & ponies must be in possession of a current negative Coggins Certificate taken within the past 12 months (of show date). ALL Coggins **MUST** be submitted to the Show Office at **each** show. No show numbers will be given without a negative Coggins certificate.
6. Junior & Amateurs must declare eligibility by checking the appropriate box on the entry form
7. "Unjudged" exhibitors will pay the regular entry fee.
8. Entry fees will be \$12.00 per class. A fee of \$25.00 will be charged for all returned checks.
9. No persons will be allowed in the show ring except on official business.
10. A discount on entries of \$2.00 per class is being offered to Pony Club and 4-H members.
Written proof of membership must be presented to the Show Office at each show for the rider to receive the discount. NO EXCEPTIONS
11. **ALL HORSES/PONIES WILL BE LIMITED TO SHOWING IN 12 CLASSES AT EACH SHOW (including classes 1-9)**
